Energy Poverty and Mental Health in a COVID-19 Context

Since the health crisis began in 2019, health authorities around the world have been regularly reporting the number of COVID 19 victims: the Covid-19 pandemic has killed over 5 million people worldwide. The United Kingdom is the European country most affected by the pandemic, reporting over 144,000 deaths. In the United States, the country with the highest number of victims, 770,000 deaths were recorded. To combat the pandemic, countries have taken numerous restrictive measures, including isolation of patients to prevent contagion, but also curfews and national confinements for the entire population. Thus, at the beginning of 2021, Germany, the United Kingdom, Belgium, Portugal and many other European countries had new measures restricting the freedom of movement of citizens. In order to break the chains of transmission, many countries have also introduced compulsory (Germany, United Kingdom, Switzerland, etc.) or voluntary (United States, France, etc.) isolation measures for sick patients (...).
